

Lambing Time on Lismore April and May

There is a right to roam in Scotland but not a right to cause damage

- Lambing time is critical for farmers - if they loose lambs then they lose their income for the rest of the year -as well as distress caused by deaths
- The Main Lambing period is April and May but young lambs remain vulnerable for several months- so special care needs to be taken between April and July
- Your presence around ewes at this time will cause them to run, this can and has resulted in injury, loss of lambs or even death of the ewe.
- If you are taking daily exercise outside, Keep to the road
- Do not go through fields during lambing time. Some ewes will run abandoning their lambs which will result in their death.
- Never pick up lambs as their ewes will reject them.
- Do not let your dog off the lead or into a field at any time
