- Deliveries of Shop Goods will take place in the afternoon on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Both the post office and shop will be closed Wednesdays and Saturdays
- Medicines will be delivered on Mondays and Thursdays

- A designated driver will deliver to your door. They will ring your doorbell or call out for you, to alert you to the arrival of your delivery. Please open the door and collect your goods. If you have a place you would prefer to have your goods left please leave a clear sign (eg: please leave in car/porch/shed etc..).
- If you are not feeling 100%, have a cold or suspect you may have Covid 19 leave a note on your door that you are in quarantine, and do not come out to meet your driver.
- Drivers have been instructed to keep at a distance of 2 metres and to sanitise their hands and any surface they touch in order to minimise risk of cross contamination.
- It is considered advisable to disinfect all shop bought items on receipt. Non porous surfaces such as glass, metal, plastic can be wiped down with soapy water or 2 tspn. bleach per pint of water and left to dry on a table top. Wash fruit and vegetables under a running tap as normal. Wipe all the surfaces that your shopping bag/box has touched.
