- PRESENT: ST / KK/ AMcG; apologies: AS It was noted that Ann MacLean Fleming had tendered her resignation. This was noted with regret. Ideas for recruiting other directors were considered.
- MINUTES: last meeting noted; AGM ST to liaise with Gill Law:
- FINANCE: payments were agreed for the following: £90 for DTAS membership; £13 to Companies House report; £36.03 Leaflet racks for the kiosks. Action on cheque signatories were to be changed removal of previous directors and the addition of the four current directors.
 Previous minutes were to be checked for the correct wording.
- PROJECTS & WORKING GROUP REPORTS: SCHOOL HOUSE: Planning appeal decision was awaited. The presence of what was thought to be a borehole cap in the garden north side was noted.
